

What are the “Friends” and what do they do?

The Friends are incorporated as a 501(c)3 to support the library and all contributions are tax deductible.

Through membership dues and other fund-raising activities, the Friends provide resources to the library above and beyond appropriations from the Town of Middletown and the State of Rhode Island.

The Friend’s membership includes over 200 families, individuals, and businesses that support Library Services and the cultural enrichment of Middletown.

The Friend’s Board meets monthly at the Library. The general membership has the opportunity to meet at the Annual Dinner, cake decorating contest with bake sale, and other social and fund raising activities.

In May 2008, we opened our Book Store, staffed by volunteers and stocked with donations from the Library and Library Patrons. The Book Store has replaced the Annual Book Sale.
